**Criteria:** In order to be considered for the Academic Basketball Camp a player **must** have a minimum GPA of 3.2/4.0 (un-weighted); **rising seniors should** have an SAT score (Math/Critical Reading) of 1100+ or an ACT composite score of 25 or higher though this is a “should”, not necessary as many academic schools have now gone to a test-optional admission policy.
